General Responsibilities

We have created the first Neighborhood Health Station in the United States – a single clinical enterprise that serves the entire population on one of our communities, an effort that brings together traditional clinical services with housing, recovery, recreational, and other community based programs of city government, with which we are closely allied.

Our clinicians enjoy the ability to practice medicine in a federally qualified facility, and have paid administration time built into their schedules, providing work-life balance not found in many healthcare facilities and private practice – this means we can truly focus on helping patients to stay healthy and on making our communities more resilient.

Required Qualifications

- Active, unrestricted, license to practice as a Nurse Practitioner in Rhode Island (in good standing)
- Current National Board Certification
- At least 2 years of primary care experience in either a primary care outpatient setting, preferably in a community health center
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively independently and as part of a team, in collaborative settings, required

Work Schedule

Full-time (40 hours) per week. On average, clinicians have schedules with fifteen to thirty minute appointment slots, and also participate in an evening and weekend on-call schedule. In addition to Physicians, we employ Advanced Practice Providers on our clinical teams; including Nurse Practitioners, Physician Assistants, and Certified Nurse Midwives.

Communication Skills

Exceptional oral and written communication and bedside manner skills needed. Proficiency in medical terminology needed. Bilingual in Spanish, Portuguese, and/or Creole a strong plus.
